



<p><b>ORGANISATION OF PRESENTATION</b>  Factors: logical organization &amp; structure; concise overview of submissions &amp; conclusion; appropriate attention &amp; weight given to some arguments over others; flexibility despite being taken off topic.</p>	 <b>10</b>
<p><b>DEVELOPMENT OF ARGUMENT</b>  Factors: understanding of the law &amp; issues; logical, persuasive arguments; pinpoint citation of authorities; appropriate use of policy arguments; addresses opposing arguments in advance (appellant) or consequentially (respondent).</p>	 <b>25</b>
<p><b>QUESTIONS FROM THE BENCH</b>  Factors: prepared for questions that can be anticipated; clear, concise &amp; direct responses; engagement with the court's views; composure &amp; courtesy despite challenges to arguments; effective integration of responses with arguments; adept treatment of irrelevant questions; ability to deal with difficult &amp; obscure questions.</p>	 <b>30</b>



<p><b>MANNER AND EXPRESSION</b> Factors: engages with the court; projects voice; articulates submissions with eloquence; use of clear &amp; simple language; displays confidence without arrogance; eye-contact with all members of the bench; courteous &amp; formal; correct citation; appropriate use of courtroom formalities; consistent style &amp; manner.</p>	<b>25</b>
<p><b>WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS</b> Factors: coverage of all issues raised in the case; well structured; clear, concise &amp; reasoned expression; supported by authorities with pinpoint citations; free from grammatical, spelling or punctuation errors; consistent with oral submissions.</p>	<b>10</b>
